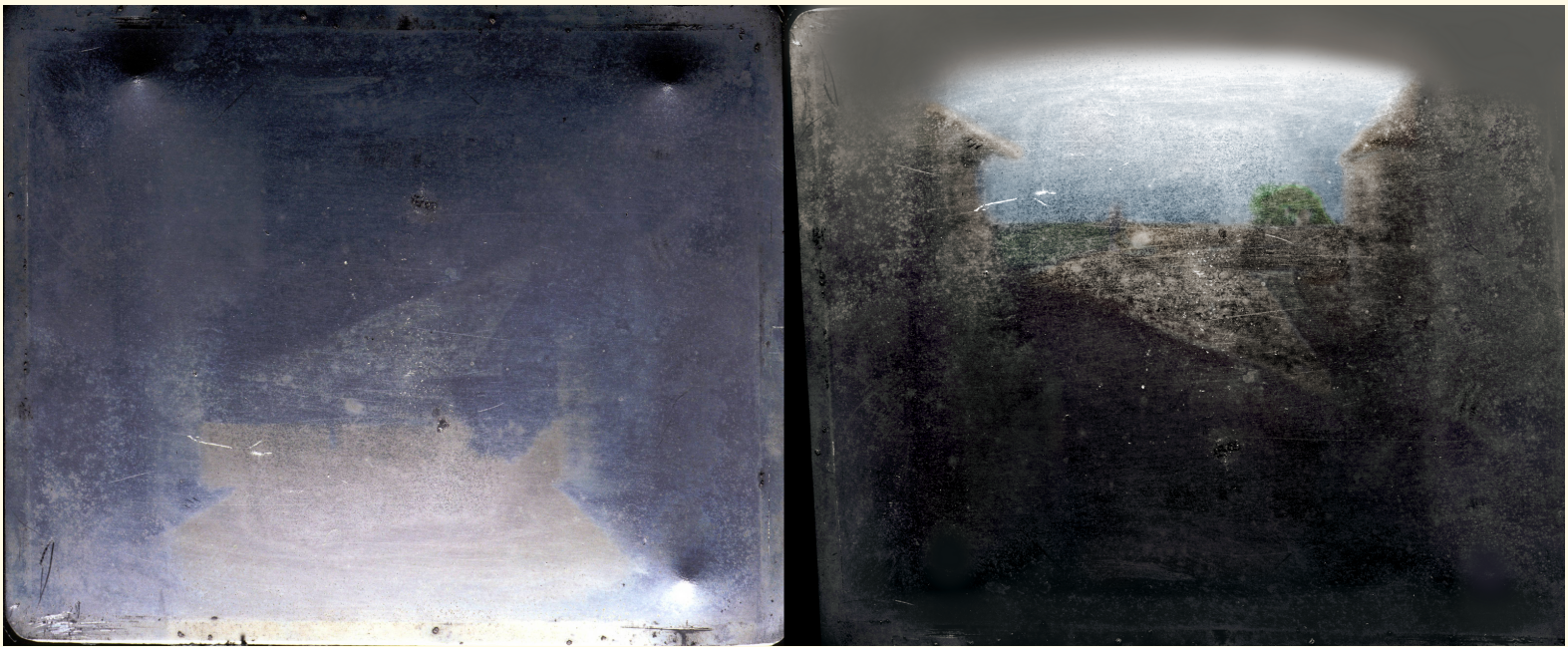

Step 1. Put your picture in the middle of your paper

Step 2. Draw lines across the paper to outline your photo

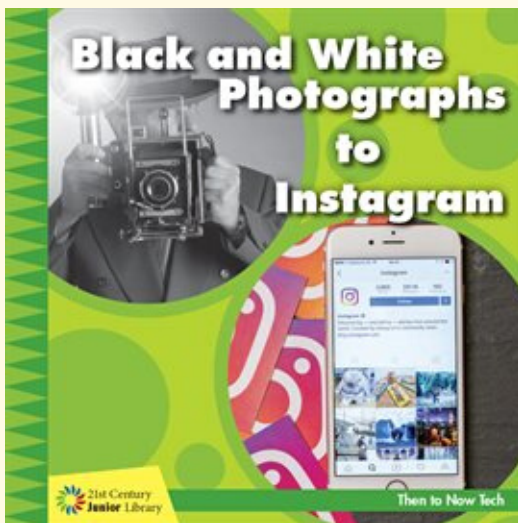
Step 3. Cut the outside corners

Step 4. Use the pencil and roll each side towards the center

Step 5. Decorate and insert your photo
