Have a story time! Watch one of the Library's or create your own.

## Sing

Sing "The Grand Old Duke of York". (Words are on the back of this sheet)

## Write

Create a picture (draw, color, paint, etc) and mail it to someone.

## Talk

Walk the Story Book Trail at Beverly Park and read the book out loud.

## Read

Share a favorite childhood book together.



## Talk

Go for a walk and talk about the different colors you see outside.

## Sing

Make up a song and sing it during bath time.



## Talk

Read an animal book and describe the animals. What do they sound like?

## Write

Find letters to trace with your finger (in a book, on a box of food, etc).

## Sing

Sing a song in a loud voice. Then sing it very quietly.



## Read

Read a book with a cover you like.



## Write

Scrunch paper into a ball and play with it by throwing, un-scrunching, etc.

## Talk

Look in a mirror and play and talk about what you see!

## Play

Play peekaboo using the words Hello and Goodbye.

## Sing

Sing "Where is King?" (words are on the back of this sheet)



## Talk

Mimic the words from your grownup or the sounds from your child.

## Play

Read under a blanket using a flashlight.
