Enlarging (and fireproofing) the openings in the old building wall would allow for easier passage between areas.




The current plan lacks closed study rooms. Although it would mean sacrificing some shelving, it would be possible to add them by the windows...


The design will need to find a balance between collection space along the radius wall and the desire for light and visibility into the study rooms...




Reconfiguration captures some additional space for the Youth Services area...




