- Plan and implement library-oriented programming, including computer training classes and book clubs.
- Assist with many forms of electronic resources on multiple device types.
- Provide technology instruction to patrons, including Internet navigation; use of Microsoft Office programs (Word, Excel, etc.); e-reader and tablet use; and the use of electronic resources, including databases, e-books, eaudiobooks, downloadable music, downloadable magazines, streaming media, and online courses.
- Maintain current job knowledge through a variety of professional development resources, some of which are self-directed.
